

## 2018 Year 7, 10 or 11 - The Bruck and Betty Wheeler Scholarship

### Information for Candidates

The **Bruck and Betty Wheeler Scholarship** is available to a **new boy** entering **Year 7, 10 or 11 in 2018**. **Applications close at 5.00pm on Friday August 4 2017**. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of school reports, references and an interview. Boys and parents are required to make applications to the Headmaster outlining their reasons for wishing to attend Prince Alfred College. A photograph of the student and any supporting documentation such as reports, references and certificates should accompany the application. (all contained within the personal folder)

### Criteria:

The **Bruck and Betty Wheeler Scholarship** is awarded to a student who can demonstrate his ability to make a significant contribution to the school; these include but are not limited to outstanding academic ability, ability in creative and performing arts, debating, leadership, sport and chess.

The key criteria for awarding The Bruck and Betty Scholarship at Prince Alfred College is as follows:

- Overall academic performance and future potential
- Achievement and involvement in other areas of excellence such as performing arts, visual arts, sport, music, debating and other relevant areas
- Citizenship, including community service
- Leadership abilities
- Without the support of this scholarship would be precluded from attending or remaining at Prince Alfred College for financial reasons.

### Scholarships for 2018:

- The **Bruck and Betty Wheeler Scholarship**: the scholarship is awarded and are tenable for up to 6 years, giving remission of up to half (50%) of tuition fees.
