Device specifications

The College recommends the following devices for Secondary School students:

- Apple MacBook Air, 256GB SSD storage
- Apple MacBook Pro 13-inch, 256GB SSD storage

AppleCare+ for Mac

The College also recommends that devices are purchased with AppleCare+ for Mac.

AppleCare+ for Mac provides up to three years of expert technical support and additional hardware coverage from Apple, including up to two incidents of accidental damage protection every 12 months. Each incident is subject to a service fee of A\$149 for screen damage or external enclosure damage, or A\$429 for other damage.
