In Week 3 of Term 4 this year, your son will be taking part in an Outdoor Education Excursion to Morialta Conservation Park.

This is a new initiative for the Junior Primary in 2025 working in partnership with the Scotts Creek Outdoor Centre staff. The purpose of the day is immersing the students in nature, introduce themes of adventure, resilience and provide a stepping stone for students to future year level camps.

Boys will explore the park on a bushwalk and engage in nature play activities. The day offers students the opportunity to grow their self-confidence with nature while interacting with the creek, woodlands, gorges, waterfalls and stunning views of the area.

Your son will travel to and from the Conservation Park by bus and will be accompanied by his classroom teacher, other Prince Alfred College staff, and a Year 11 Leader. The Scotts Creek Outdoor Centre team will facilitate the program.

# Clothing, Gear and Equipment List
