Key responsibilities will include:

Program Coordinator:

- Coaching and mentoring other instructional staff

Outdoor Education Instructor:

- Deliver and supervise student's outdoor education programs
- Focus on safety of activities and care of students
- Reporting on student progress

The successful applicants will be experienced Outdoor Educators with a passion for delivering exceptional programs for

students. Along with Outdoor Education qualifications, you will have experience in either bushwalking, rock climbing, kayaking, white water or a high ropes course. The role is based on site at our Scotts Creek campus located in the Riverland just out of Morgan. Accommodation is provided on site and all meals provided during program days.

The roles are being offered as a fixed-term contract for one year in the first instance, starting in January 2023. The positions may be from a 40 week contract to full-time positions.
