BOOKING INFORMATION

Our program caters for children from Reception to Year 6. We aim to provide a safe, stimulating environment for the children to enjoy their school holidays. Places are limited and days may be fully booked prior to the closing date so to avoid disappointment please return your booking form ASAP.

OPERATING HOURS

The program operates between 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Friday. You may drop off or pick up your children anytime between these hours. Remember to sign your children in and out each day.

PROGRAM

A range of activities will be offered during the day including craft, board games, sports, playground, plus our main morning and afternoon activities. The program will be displayed on the notice board and the entrance doors.

STAFF

We operate on a minimum ratio of 1 staff member to 15 children onsite. During excursions, we will operate with a minimum ratio of 1 staff member to 10 children. When swimming/water activities are involved, we will operate with a minimum ratio of 1 staff member to 5 children.

BOOKINGS

Please complete the attached booking form indicating the days you require and return by Monday 30 November 2020. Bookings made after this date will be accepted (with additional fee) but may remain pending until appropriate staff/child ratio is reached. Once your booking form is received, a booking confirmation will be emailed confirming days booked, what to bring and any other special requirements.

No bookings are accepted or entered until booking forms are completed in full and returned.

The booking confirmations will be sent after the closing date.

WAITLIST

If a day is fully booked your children can be placed on a waiting list and we will notify you if a place becomes available.

CANCELLATIONS

If a cancellation is made you will be charged the full fee for dates booked unless we are able to fill your child's spot with a child on the waitlist. However, if your child cannot attend due to illness please provide a doctor's certificate and fees will be waived.

FEES

Summer 2020-21 — \$61 per child per day, plus extra for excursions or special activities as indicated.

If booking request form is submitted after the cut-off date an additional \$4 fee will be charged to the daily amount.

FEE PAYMENT

You will be billed through the fortnightly billing cycle. Please log in to your Xplor account to see your statement. The nominated account will be debited on the Tuesday. All payments will be processed using Ezidebit.

All payment details must be kept current. Payment must be made using our Ezidebit system.

CHILD CARE SUBSIDY (CCS)

Prince Alfred College OSHC is an Approved Provider. If you wish to claim CCS you will need to provide us with your Customer Reference Number (CRN) from Centrelink. For more information or to obtain a Customer Reference Number please visit https://www.humanservices.gov.au.

FOOD (NOT SUPPLIED)

Morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and a drink bottle must be brought each day unless indicated otherwise. We suggest the children bring extra morning and afternoon snacks. There is water available.

We follow Prince Alfred College's Nut Aware Policy. <u>No nuts</u> are to be brought into the OSHC nor will they be used in any activities. All external providers are made aware that we are Nut Aware.

CLOTHING & BELONGINGS

Please ensure all items of clothing and belongings are named. Appropriate clothing should be worn according to the program. No singlets or short shorts (due to sun safety). Shoes must be enclosed. **The children must bring a hat every day** otherwise they will be required to stay in the shaded areas. A hat and sunscreen *must* be worn for all outdoor activities.
