

## Introduction

The Prince Alfred College uniform is an integral part of the College's identity and contributes to a strong sense of belonging and community spirit.

School uniform must be worn while at school, travelling to and from school, and on those occasions specified by the Headmaster or delegate. It is a fundamental expectation of all students that they wear the correct uniform and present themselves to the highest standard.

Uniform items should be clearly marked with name tags, and all equipment permanently marked with a name and telephone number.

#### **Second-Hand Uniforms**

We accept good quality second-hand uniforms on consignment throughout the year. Items need to be laundered and pressed, and name tags removed, prior to return. Blazers need to be dry cleaned.



## Early Learning Centre

The Early Learning Centre uniform comprises warm and cool weather options, which can be worn year-round for indoor and outdoor play.

Children are encouraged to use their own backpack when starting in the Early Learning Centre so that they have something of their own and can easily identify their own school bag.

Children in the three and four-year-old programs also require a Library Bag for their weekly Library Visit. Library Bags purchased from the College Shop can also be used in Preparatory School.

#### **Warm Weather Options**

**Polo shirt |** Maroon short-sleeve banded polo shirt with College crest.

**Shorts** | Maroon. Students may also wear plain navy, black or a neutral tone.

**Hat |** Maroon legionnaire-style hat with College crest. Must be worn from 1 September to 30 April.



#### **Cool Weather Options**

**Polo Shirt |** As per summer uniform.

**Rugby Jumper |** Maroon long-sleeve rugby jumper with College crest.

**Track Pants** | Maroon. Students may also wear plain navy, black or a neutral tone.

**Reception - Year 6** 

#### Summer Uniform (Terms 1 & 4)

**Shirt |** White, short-sleeve with College crest.

**Shorts** | Charcoal grey with elastic back.

Jumper (optional) | Maroon v-neck with College crest.

**Socks** | Black knee length with red and white bands.

**Shoes** | Polished black leather lace-up school shoes with stepped heel and black laces. In Terms 1 and 4, brown leather sandals may be worn as an alternative.

Hat | Khaki bucket hat with College crest.



#### Winter Uniform (Terms 2 & 3)

Blazer | Maroon with white braid and College crest.Shirt | White, long-sleeve, banded no College crest.Trousers | Charcoal grey with elastic back.Jumper | Maroon v-neck with College crest.Tie | Crested (loop optional).Socks | As per summer uniform.Shoes | As per summer uniform.



### Secondary School

Years 7 -12

#### Summer Uniform (Terms 1 & 4)

Shirt | White, short-sleeve with College crest.
Shorts | Charcoal grey with pleat.
Jumper (optional) | Maroon v-neck with College crest.
Belt (optional) | Black.
Socks | Black calf length with red and white band.
Shoes | Polished black leather lace-up school shoes with stepped heel and black laces.
Hat | Khaki with College crest.



#### Winter Uniform (Terms 2 & 3)

**Blazer** | Maroon with white braid and College crest.

**Shirt |** White, long-sleeve no College crest.

**Trousers** | Charcoal grey with pleat.

**Jumper |** Maroon v-neck with College crest.

Belt | Black.

**Tie |** (Years 7 to 9) Crested with maroon stripe or (Years 10 to 12) Crested with white stripe.

**Socks** | As per summer uniform.

**Shoes** | As per summer uniform.



### Sport Reception to Year 12

Shorts | Charcoal.
Shirt | Red polo with College crest.
Track Jacket | (Reception to Year 3) Red fleecy lined ½ zip, with College crest or (Years 4 to 12) Red microfibre with College crest.
Track Pants | (Reception to Year 3) Charcoal fleecy lined with zips or (Years 4 to 12) Charcoal microfibre with zips.
Socks | White with red bands.

Bathers | Charcoal board shorts.

**Sport Shoes** | Predominantly white, non-marking soles.



### House

**Reception to Year 12** 

House Shirt | Coloured polo with house monogram.

To be worn for House events, including Athletics Day, Cross Country, Swimming Carnival and other activities.



## Co-curricular Sports Uniform

#### Year 7-12

Secondary School students participate in a co-curricular activity in both the Summer and Winter terms. In Years 11 and 12 boys are only required to participate in one season, although they may choose to do both.

Specialised uniform must be purchased depending on the chosen activity, a selection of which is shown here.

**Preparatory School** Reception – Year 6

Boys from Reception to Year 6 are required to wear the Preparatory School Tie in Terms 2 and 3.

We encourage all boys to purchase a self-tying tie, though elastic ties are available for those needing dexterity assistance.

Years 7 – 12

Boys from Year 7 - 9 wear the Middle School Tie in Terms 2 and 3.


Boys from Year 10 - 11 wear the Senior School Tie in Terms 2 and 3.
