Seymour College Sibling Discount

Single Studies Music Lessons

Parents of students wishing to receive individual music instruction should contact the Music Department on 8334 1235 to make arrangements. Unless notified otherwise, accounts for music tuition will be rendered by, and are payable direct to, the instrumental teacher, not the College.

Miscellaneous Charges

Accounts for optional items are issued at the end of each term. Due dates in 2013 are **Friday 10 May, Friday 9 August, Friday 25 October and Friday 13 December**. Please note that as Term Charges are variable, they are not included in amounts in this Fee Schedule.

Building Fund – Voluntary Donation

\$150.00 per child, per fee instalment. This is a voluntary payment which is tax deductible.

Terms and Conditions

- *Boarding Fees include applicable GST and an additional Boarding Consolidated Charge of \$693.
- Each fee instalment is due and payable by the due date, failing which a late payment fee of \$100.00 will be levied and the remainder of the year's fees become due immediately.
- The College Council reserves the right to terminate attendance of a student whose account remains unpaid at the due date.
- All payments made with Visa, MasterCard or American Express attract a 1% surcharge.
- A full term's written notice must be provided to the Headmaster advising the withdrawal of a student from the College or a change in their boarding status, otherwise one term's fee will be payable in lieu of notice.
- Receipts will be forwarded for Building Fund donations, but not for fees and charges unless specifically requested.
- Grants from Commonwealth and State Governments have been taken into account in determining the Annual Fees.

Payment Methods

Fees and charges may be paid by BPAY, internet transfer, cash, cheque, EFTPOS, or credit card (MasterCard, AMEX and Visa). The College's banking details are located on the back of the invoice/statement.

The College provides the following fee payment options for Australian Residents. Please refer to the table below for details of the amounts due:

Full Year's Fees in Advance

A discount of 2% will be granted where payment of the full year's fees is received by Friday 15 February 2013.

Three Instalments

The due dates for payment of fees by three instalments in 2013 are **Friday 15 February, Friday 10 May and Friday 9 August.**

Monthly Instalments

Monthly instalments are processed on the 15th of the month, over ten months, from February to November, and can only be made by direct debit to a savings or cheque account, or to a credit card. A 1% administrative fee is included in the monthly instalments. - Overseas Student Health Cover for total duration of study at Prince Alfred College

Ongoing Students

Ongoing students are invoiced in December of each year for the following school year for:

- Tuition Fees for one year
- Boarding Fee (if applicable)
- Consolidated Charge for one year
- International Baccalaureate Diploma Fee (if applicable)

Payment is due by 15 January after the issue of the invoice.
