FACILITIES

ANZAC HALL

ANZAC Hall is a school assembly hall. The auditorium seats approximately 900. The Hall is not a Theatre, the lighting rig is not large enough to provide for coloured stage lighting and "specials". The Hall does not have a talkback intercom system.

ANZAC HALL - TECHNICAL PROVISIONS

LIGHTING

- 24 channels of dimmers
- Flat white lighting ONLY – no colours or specials available
- 2 follow spots
- 3 lighting bars over stage on winches
- Front of house bar – fixed ceiling mounted available only by hoist (*NB: The use of an elevated work platform must be negotiated with our Director of School Operations*)
- No Smoke Machines, dry ice only
