Consolidated Charge

The Consolidated Charge is compulsory and covers most curriculum activities such as camps, excursions, theatrical performances and many of the costs associated with the sport and co-curricular programs offered by the College. Please note, however, that the Consolidated Charge does not include expenses such as interstate and overseas visits, textbooks, secondary school stationery and individual requirements for art, applied design, photography, technical studies, metalwork, woodwork, special projects and outdoor education. These items will be charged at the end of each term

Student Laptops

All students in Years 7 to 12 are required to purchase a nominated device via the College website.

Sibling Discount

For the second son:	10%	For the third son:	20%

Discount may not apply where some other form of assistance, such as a scholarship or bursary, is provided to a brother. Applicable to Tuition and Boarding Fees only – does not include Consolidated Charge.

Seymour College Sibling Discount

If you have children attending Prince Alfred College and Seymour College at the same time, you are eligible for a 5% sibling discount at each College. An application form can be downloaded from the Enrolments link on the home page of the College website.

Single Studies Music Lessons

Parents of students wishing to receive individual music instruction should contact the Music Department on 8334 1235 to make arrangements. Unless notified otherwise, accounts for music tuition will be rendered by, and are payable directly to, the instrumental teacher, not the College.

Miscellaneous Charges

Accounts for optional items are issued at the end of each term. Due dates in 2019 are **Friday 10 May, Friday 2 August, Friday 25 October** and **Friday 13 December**. Please note that as Term Charges are variable, they are not included in amounts in this Fee Schedule.

Building Fund – Voluntary Donation

\$150.00 per child, per fee instalment. This voluntary payment is tax deductible.

Interest on Overdue Fees

Interest on overdue accounts is charged at the prevailing published rate of the Westpac Bank Business Overdraft on the date the interest charge is levied on the account by the College.

Terms and Conditions

- Boarding Fees include an additional Boarding Consolidated Charge of \$858 (GST inclusive).
- Failure to pay fees by the due date will incur a late payment fee of \$100.
- The College Council reserves the right to terminate attendance of a student whose account remains unpaid at the due date.
- A full term's written notice must be provided to the Headmaster advising the withdrawal of a student from the College or a change in their boarding status, otherwise one term's fee will be payable in lieu of notice.
- Tax deductible receipts will be forwarded for Building Fund donations.
- Grants from Commonwealth and State Governments have been taken into account in determining the annual fees.

Methods of Payment

Full Year's Fees in Advance

A discount of 2% will be granted where payment of the full year's fees is received by Friday 8 February 2019.

Three Instalments – Due Dates

The due dates for payment of fees by three instalments in 2019 are:

- **Friday 8 February 2019** **Friday 10 May 2019** **Friday 2 August 2019**

Monthly Instalments

- Monthly instalments are processed on either the 15th of the month or the last Friday of the month, over ten months, from February to November.
- Instalments can only be made by direct debit to a savings/cheque account or to a credit card.
- A 1% administrative fee is included in the monthly instalments.

If you paid by monthly direct debit in 2018, this will continue automatically in 2019. You will be notified of the new amount before the first deduction. Please contact Mrs Simonetti if you wish to vary this arrangement.

International Students are invoiced on the following basis:

New Students

To obtain Confirmation of Enrolment a payment of the following is required:

- Tuition Fee for one semester
- Consolidated Charge for one semester
- Boarding Fee for one semester (if applicable)
- International Baccalaureate Diploma Fee (if applicable)
- Application Fee + Enrolment Fee \$1,350
- Refundable Deposit \$1,000 – to be offset against any final charges at the end of Year 12
- Overseas Student Health Cover for total duration of study at Prince Alfred College
- Homestay matching fee \$280 (if applicable)
- Homestay fee for 4 weeks \$1240 (if applicable)

Ongoing Students

Ongoing students are invoiced in December of each year for the following school year for:

- Tuition Fees for one year
- Consolidated Charge for one year
- Boarding Fee for one year (if applicable)
- International Baccalaureate Diploma Fee (if applicable)

Payment is due by 15th January 2019. Please note that the 2% fees in advance discount has been factored into the international student fee rates.
