
We are pleased to report on the academic performance of our graduating students from 2019.

The graduating students of 2019 performed strongly in their Year 12 studies and the median ATAR score of 85.70 contained many commendable performances.

Yash Giri was named as Dux of School for a perfect ATAR of 99.95 in addition to six subject merits. Ross Porter was the Proxime Accessit to the Dux, also scoring 99.95, with four subject merits. The vast majority of students achieved their first preference for university entrance and we wish all of 2019's leavers the very best for future endeavours.

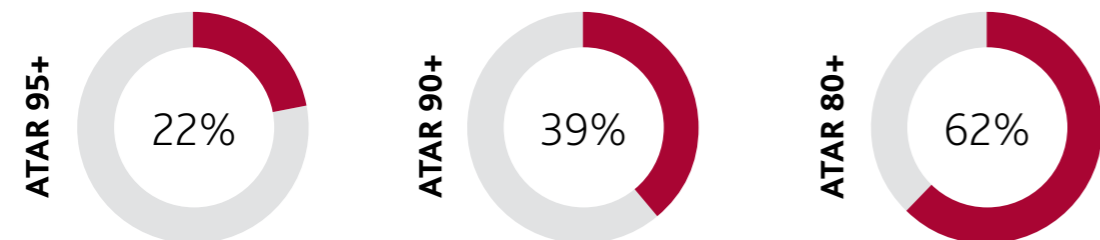
20% of students achieved an ATAR of at least 95 and we inducted 33 in the College 'Over 95' club.

52 merits were obtained by 29 students, bringing the number of merits awarded in the last three years to 176. This contrasts with 127 merits awarded during the previous three years (2014 – 16), an increase of almost 40%. Merits were awarded in 31 separate subjects or courses in 2019, demonstrating academic excellence across the full subject range.

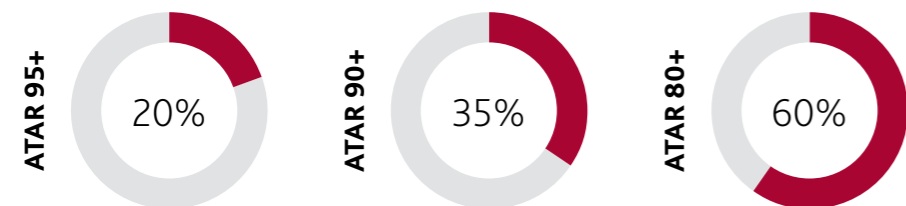

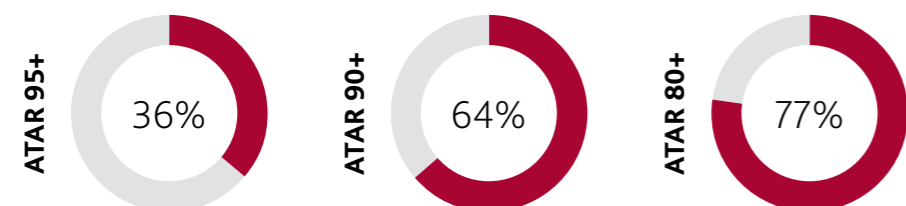
### SACE and IBDP combined ATARs



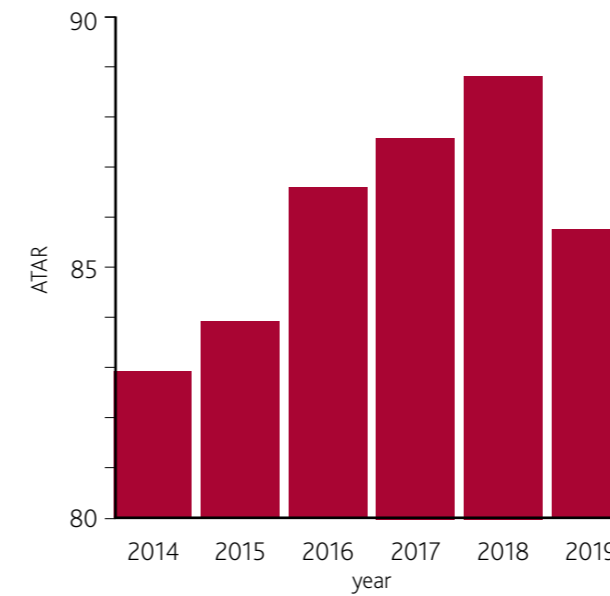
### SACE ATARs



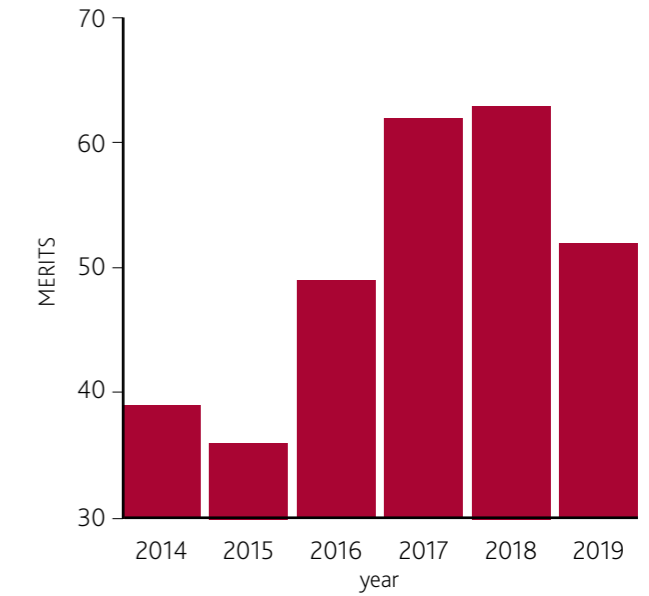
### IBDP ATARs
